



## CAMPER VAN CLEANING CHECKLIST

### While you clean:

- Wear disposable gear while you clean (gloves, face masks).
- Ventilate rooms while you clean by leaving the windows and door open.
- Wash your hands thoroughly before and after each cleaning.
- Use detergent or soap and water to remove dirt, grease, dust, and germs. Once the surface is clean, spray with a disinfectant.
- Don't touch your face while cleaning.
- Wash all linens at the highest heat setting recommended by the manufacturer.
- While restocking your supplies, take a moment to check expiration dates.
- Line your trash cans to make it easier to dispose of waste.
- Once you're done cleaning, immediately take out the trash if it contains cleaning supplies like used paper towels or disinfectant wipes.

### Make sure your RV is stocked up on the following for renter use:

- Antibacterial hand sanitizer
- Disposable gloves and wipes
- Hand soap
- Paper towels
- Tissues
- Toilet Paper
